

Salem Board of Christian Education Meeting Summary

- Paige Basler called the June 2011 meeting of the Board of Christian Education to order with 10 members present.
- Pastor led us with a devotion and prayer.
- Secretary's Report: Mary Reinhardt made a motion to accept the Secretary's Report and Dawn Reagan seconded. The motion passed.

Corinne Fish presented a bill for \$475.50 for pizza fundraiser. A total of \$985.00 was collected for pizzas. A motion was made by Donita Prott and seconded by Mary Reinhardt to transfer money from the Youth Fund from the Youth Mission Fund to pay the CSM installment due for the mission trip. The money will be later returned to the fund. The motion also requested for bills presented to be paid. The motion passed.
